

EYC 2021 – Covid-19 protocol

General rules

- Clean hands as much as possible
- Try to keep 1,5m distance of each other
- When feeling sick, report yourself with your team manager



Extra EYC rules for athletes and staff

- Show proof of vaccination, proof of recovery or a negative test result (this includes the Digital COVID Certificate) at arrival to receive accreditation.
When you did not bring a negative test result from your home country, please make an appointment at 'Testen voor Toegang' before arriving in Tilburg:

- Test on Monday morning September 13th if not vaccinated or recovered
- Test on Thursday morning September 16th if not vaccinated or recovered

Bowling – athletes & officials

- unlimited access in the bowling center
- Cleaning hands when entering the center
- Visually wearing accreditation at all times
- If not playing, watch matches from the balcony
- Be seated at all times

Bowling – Spectators

- In total 2 spectators per player can have access to the center at the same time. They need to be registered with the organisation in advance, starting from Sunday September 12th.
- On Thursday 9th, Friday 10th and Saturday 11th, no spectators are welcome in the bowling center.
- To enter the center, spectators need to show one of the following:
 - proof of vaccination
 - proof of recovery
 - a negative test result (this includes the Digital COVID Certificate)
- Cleaning hands when entering the center
- Visually wearing specific arm band at all times
- Be seated at all times

Bus

- Visually wearing accreditation at all times
- Wearing a mask at all times

Hotel

- Follow the rules of the hotel.



Protocol when an athlete/official is feeling sick or tested positive:

- When an athlete or official is feeling sick, host will provide a test to determine if Covid is the source.
- When an athlete or official is tested positive, he/she needs to go in quarantine in the hotel:
 - All members of the same delegation of the athlete or official need to be tested as well
 - The athlete or official must stay in his / her room for the remaining of the championships or go home (if possible).
 - The roommate will have to join another room of the team in the hotel. (extra bed possible?)
- When an athlete or official cannot go home yet because of the positive test, they need to stay in the hotel for as long as necessary. Extra hotel and travel costs are for the team itself after September 19th.
